The Wilderness Team is a diverse group of individuals who travel to Honduras annually to partner with the people of the Agalta Valley to improve the quality of life in the region through education, health care and commerce.

The group will be making its annual trip to Honduras, February 28 - March 7, 2026.

The evening will also feature authentic Latin cuisine, a silent auction filled with must-have sports, entertainment and travel items, a wine pull and a documentary by Byron Small.
